

Outdoor Summer Adventure Day Trip

Situated in the picturesque Pembina Valley, Carman offers a wide variety of scenic summer activities for outdoor adventurers.

When to go:
June – October

Morning: Take a Hike!

Just a 20 minute drive west of Carman, **Stephenfield Provincial Park** offers over 12 km of scenic trails, perfect for bird watching and spotting flora and fauna. Trails are well-marked, with ample facilities and shaded, grassy picnic and rest areas. The park also offers space for kayaking, canoeing, boating and fishing. Only 30 minutes west of Carman is the Birch Ski area, which boasts over 25 km of trails for hiking and running. With difficulty levels ranging from amateur to expert, these trails offer beautiful views of the valley with rolling hills and gullies, and a central clubhouse and restroom.

Bring:

- Proper footwear
- Water
- Mosquito repellent
- Sunscreen
- Orientation instruments
- A whistle & necessary safety gear

Lunch: Classic Comfort Food

Enjoy the fresh air while taking in the retro character of a time gone-by with a trip to the famous **Syl's Drive Inn**. Syl's has maintained the authentic look, feel and service of a traditional drive-in while serving up classic favourites like burgers, subs and seriously thick shakes.



Afternoon: Break a Sweat or Beat the Heat

Head to **King's Park**, located just within Carman. Work on your serves on the well-kept outdoor tennis and beach volleyball courts or hit a home run at the baseball diamonds. If you're looking to cool down and unwind, take a dip at the outdoor pool, also located within the park, or simply find some shade, kick back and enjoy the foliage.

Dinner: Take Time to Unwind

Put your feet up and enjoy a hearty platter with a gorgeous view from the outdoor terrace of **McGee's Restaurant at the Carman Golf & Curling Club**. A mainstay popular with locals and visitors alike, this licensed restaurant serves up family-style food and an wide array of classic platters in a relaxed dining atmosphere.

Additional Activity: Carman Country Fair – July 7–9, 2016

The **Carman Country Fair** is held annually over the second weekend in July and is one of the oldest running fairs in Manitoba. Events include midway rides, food booths, tradeshow venues, motor sports shows, a talent show, fireworks, livestock shows, great live entertainment and the first annual Manitoba Lumberjack Competition.
