

TOWN OF CARMAN

BY-LAW NO. 01/1840

**Being a by-law of the Town of Carman to designate
the Memorial Hall a non-smoking public building.**

WHEREAS the Town of Carman and the Rural Municipality of Dufferin are joint owners of the public building commonly known as the Memorial Hall located in the Town of Carman, on the property legally described as follows:

"Most northerly 132 feet in length of the lane in Block 2, Plan 24; Lot 12, Block 2, Plan 24, excluding the south 18 feet; All of lots 13 through 21, inclusive, in Block 2, Plan 24, as shown on Certificate of Title Number 1557725, registered in the Morden Land Titles Office, Morden, Manitoba."

AND WHEREAS Section 3(1) of the Non-Smokers Health Protection Act states as follows:

"Subject to Section 3 and the regulations, no person shall smoke in an enclosed public place or in a motor vehicle;"

AND WHEREAS Section 6(1) of the Non-Smokers Health Protection Act states as follows:

"Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act, a municipal Council may pass a by-law to limit or ban smoking in any enclosed public place in the municipality."


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Carman deems it expedient and in the best interest of the public to designate the Memorial Hall building a non-smoking facility and to ban smoking in the building;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carman, duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** the Memorial Hall building be declared as a non-smoking public building where smoking is prohibited.
2. **THAT** this by-law will be enforced as per the regulations specified in the Non-Smokers Health Protection Act, Province of Manitoba.
3. **THAT** this by-law shall come into effect upon its passing.

DONE AND PASSED, as a by-law of the Town of Carman, in the Province of Manitoba, this day of May, A.D. 2001.
