

TOWN OF CARMAN

BY-LAW NO. 01/1846

**BEING a By-law of the Town of Carman providing
for the preparation of a list of electors for the Town.**

WHEREAS the *Local Authorities Election Act*, L.R.M. 1987, c. L180, Section 11(1), states

“The council of a local authority may by-law provide that a list of electors shall be made

- (a) in each year; or
- (b) in each year in which a regular election is held;
- or
- (c) in each fourth year;

and the enumerator of the local authority shall, in each year in which a list of electors is required to be made, make as provided herein, a list of electors of the authority.”

AND WHEREAS the *Local Authorities Election Act*, L.R.M. 1987, c. L180, Section 19(4), states


“The local authority may, by by-law, reduce to two or one the number of days upon which the revising officer shall sit for the purpose of revising the list; and, where the local authority passes a by-law under this section, the public notice referred to under subsection (1) shall refer to two days or one day, as the case may be.”


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Carman, in Council duly assembled, as follows:

1. **THAT** the Town of Carman has its list of electors prepared in each year in which a regular election is held.
2. **THAT** the number of days the revising officer shall sit for the purpose of revising the list of electors shall be set at one day.
3. **THAT** all other by-laws of the Town of Carman for the purposes of preparing and revising the list of electors shall be rescinded.
