

TOWN OF CARMAN

BY-LAW NO. 03/1865

Being a by-law of the Town of Carman to amend Zoning
By-law No. 92/1707 of the Town of Carman, as amended.

WHEREAS Section 47(2) of The Planning Act gives the council of a municipality the
power to amend a Zoning By-law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Carman enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Zoning Map, being Schedule "A" of the Town of Carman Zoning By-
law No. 92/1707, be amended so that Pt. NE¼ 24-6-5W and Pt. Lot 12, Plan 1080
MLTO,

as shown outlined in a heavy line on the map attached hereto as Schedule "A",
and forming part of this by-law, be rezoned


FROM: Partly "AL" Agriculture-Limited Zone and Partly "RT" Residential
Two Family Zone
TO: "I" Institutional Zone


2. That Table 8-1 "Institutional, Open Space, Recreation and Agriculture Use Table"
be amended to include the following as a new category:

18. Emergency Services
Including ambulance and fire services

as a Permitted use in the "I" Institutional Zone and subject to Parking Group
No. 20 in Table 9-2 (Parking Group Table)

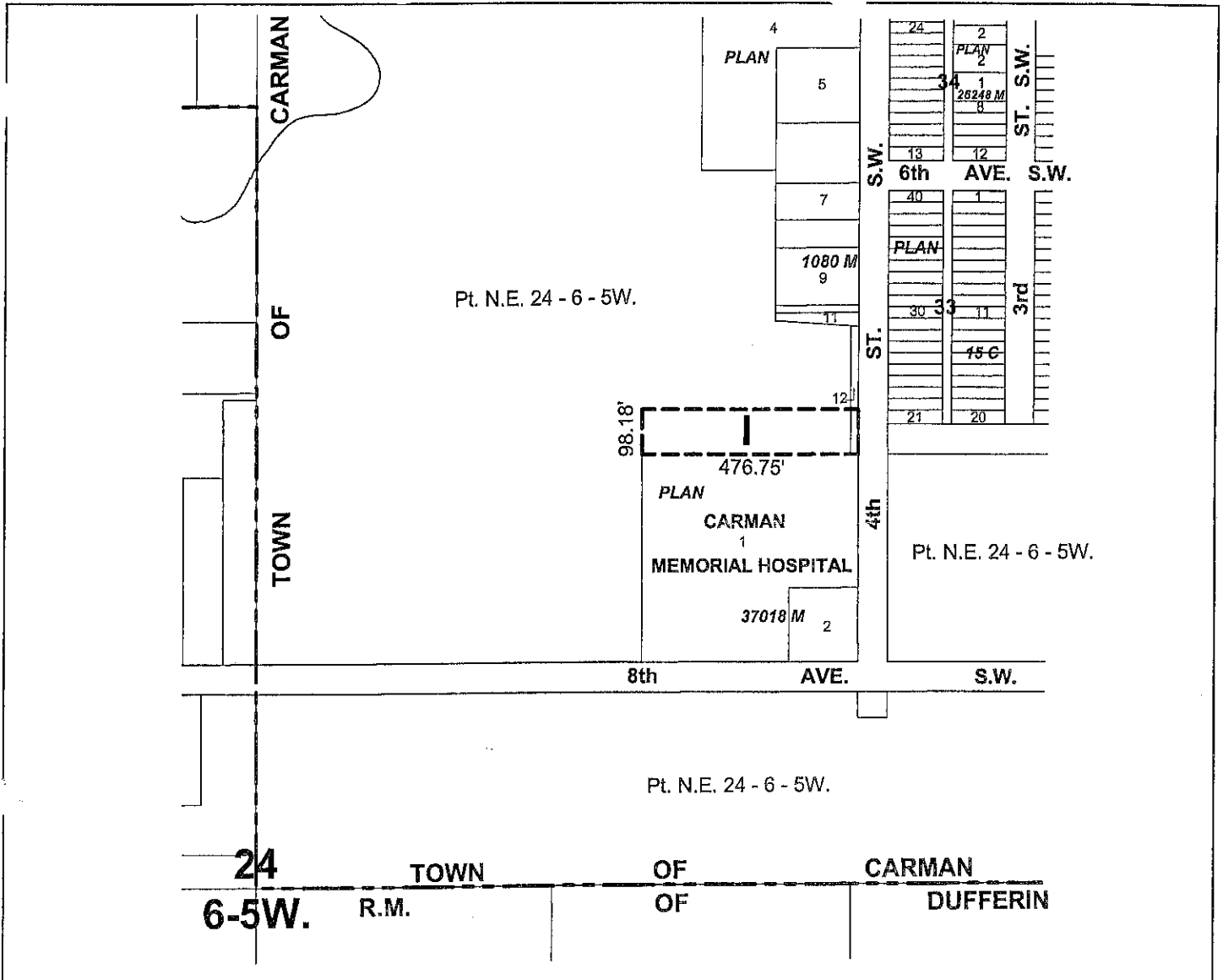
