Single-use wipes have become the main culprit in additional repairs of municipal sewage systems, clogging pipes and causing millions of dollars in damage and clean-up costs every year. For the sake of your plumbing either dispose of wipes in the trashcan or stop using them to



avoid a messy and potentially expensive disaster.

Keep the wipes out of the pipes, unless you like paying plumbers and/or cleaning up after sewage backups.

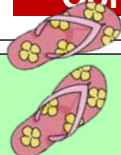

Recycle pickup is the same day as garbage

Paper, milk cartons, glass, plastic #1, #2, #4, #5, #7, aluminum, tin, corrugated cardboard, rechargeable batteries

Items can now be co-mingled in same box

RGN– Tuesday is regular **RECYCLE** and **GARBAGE** pickup day NORTH of Centre Ave

RGS – Thursday is regular **RECYCLE** and **GARBAGE** pickup day SOUTH of Centre Ave

When garbage and recycle fall on a **scheduled holiday**, pickup is the next working day

Green Day – Compost pickup every Monday – May 4 to November 4, 2019
When Green Day falls on a **scheduled holiday** pickup is the Friday before

Mosquito Fogging Schedule

Ground fogging of the entire Town of Carman plus a 3 km buffer zone, for the control of mosquitoes with Malathion ULV will commence **THURSDAY** evenings at 10:00 pm until **FRIDAY** morning ending at 6:00 am.

Fogging will be suspended on any scheduled day if:

1. Temperature is below 13° Celsius
2. Rain
3. Wind speeds are too high and not conducive for effective adult mosquito control
4. Statutory Holiday



NOTE CHANGE OF POLICY: Should fogging be cancelled or suspended on any scheduled day it will commence the next acceptable night.

Fogging will commence when daily landing counts exceed an average of one landing per minute over a ten minute period.

Buffer zones will be recognized during fogging unless a Province of Manitoba Health Order has been issued.

CAMPER or TRAILER PARKING

The Town Traffic By-law #14/1993 **PROHIBITS** an unattended or unattached trailer of **any type** from parking on any street within the Town **EXCEPT** to load or unload. Fines for infractions of this by-law shall not exceed one thousand dollars, plus costs.

- More than 30% of household water is consumed outdoors, such as watering lawns.

Planning District

A building permit is required to install a pool and/or hot tub. If the pool depth (body of water) is 24 inches and more, then you will be required to install a fence prior to filling the pool.

All outdoor pools and hot tubs shall be completely enclosed with a fence or other suitable barrier constructed or erected in accordance with the following:

- It shall have a height of six (6) feet including gates that shall be self-closing and equipped with a lockable latch to prevent unauthorized entry.
- There shall be no openings other than an entry to a building or a gate and it shall be constructed so as to prevent a child from crawling under either the fence or gate.
- Where other than chain link is used, the outside surface of the enclosure shall be relatively smooth so as not to provide foot or toe holds.
- The enclosure surrounding an outdoor pool shall be maintained in good repair.
