

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN

By-Law No. 1610

**A by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin
to fix the remuneration of certain employees
for the year 1991.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 164 of The Municipal Act, R.S.M. 1988, C.100 - Cap. M225, the Council of a municipality shall, by by-law, provide for the payment of all municipal officers and employees and shall fix the remuneration of any officer or employee whose remuneration is not fixed by the Act of the Legislature;


THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin, in regular session duly assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the remuneration to be paid to the employees of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin hereinafter referred to, shall be as hereunder set out:



Andy Bruce, Foreman	\$34,110 per year
Ken Young, Asst. Foreman	\$11.75 per hour
Linda Colpitts, Secretary-Treasurer	\$32,100 per year
Ruth Stege, Asst. Secretary-Treasurer	\$23,000 per year
Machine Operators	\$11.25 per hour
Crawler Tractor Operators	\$11.50 per hour
Glen Carr, Weed Supervisor	\$26,750 per year
Barrie Fraser	\$9.30 per hour
Casual Labourers	\$6.50/hr for first two weeks, and \$7.00/hr. thereafter

2. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January A.D. 1991.
