

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN

By-Law No. 1629

**Being a by-law of the municipality authorizing  
the creation of a Provincial Road Reserve**

WHEREAS Section 574, Subsection (1) and Subsection (2) of the Municipal Act provides as follows:

574 (1) "Subject to the approval of the minister, the council of of a municipality may pass by-laws for creating a reserve fund for any purpose within the powers or duties conferred or charged on it under this Act or any other Act of the Legislature"

574 (2) "A reserve fund may be created or augmented  
(a) from surplus monies of the municipality not necessarily required;"

AND WHEREAS the Province of Manitoba is transferring 23.1 Km. of Provincial Road to the R.M. of Dufferin as per the attached map;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Government is providing a one-time compensation grant from the Province of Manitoba to the Rural Municipality of Dufferin in the amount of \$80,850.00, being 23.1 Km. of road at \$3,500.00 per Km, and payable as follows:


\$40,425.00 payable April, 1992 A.D. and  
\$40,425.00 payable April, 1993 A.D.

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Duffein deems it to be in the best interest of the municipality to create a reserve to be referred to as the "Provincial Road Reserve Fund";


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin:


1. That a Provincial Road Reserve Fund be and hereby is created;
2. That the sum of \$40,425.00 be deposited into the Provincial Road Reserve in the year 1992 and \$40,425.00 be deposited into the Provincial Road Reserve in the year 1993;
3. That the funds in this reserve shall be expended for the maintenance and construction of the Provincial Roads transferred as per the attached map and the funds shall be divided between Ward 1 - 85.71% and Ward 6 - 14.29% and to be expended accordingly.
4. That the corporation shall keep both in its books and in the bank, a separate account designating the purpose for which the fund was created, and showing at all times the state of the Reserve Fund created hereby;
5. That if the reserve fund or any portion thereof is invested, the securities therefrom shall be earmarked and kept separate from other securities of the corporation;
6. That no portion of the Provincial Road Reserve Fund or any accretions thereof shall be applied or expended by the corporation, or the Council, or any member or officer thereof, for any purpose, unless the approval of the Minister has first been obtained.
7. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date it receives approval from the Minister of Rural Development.

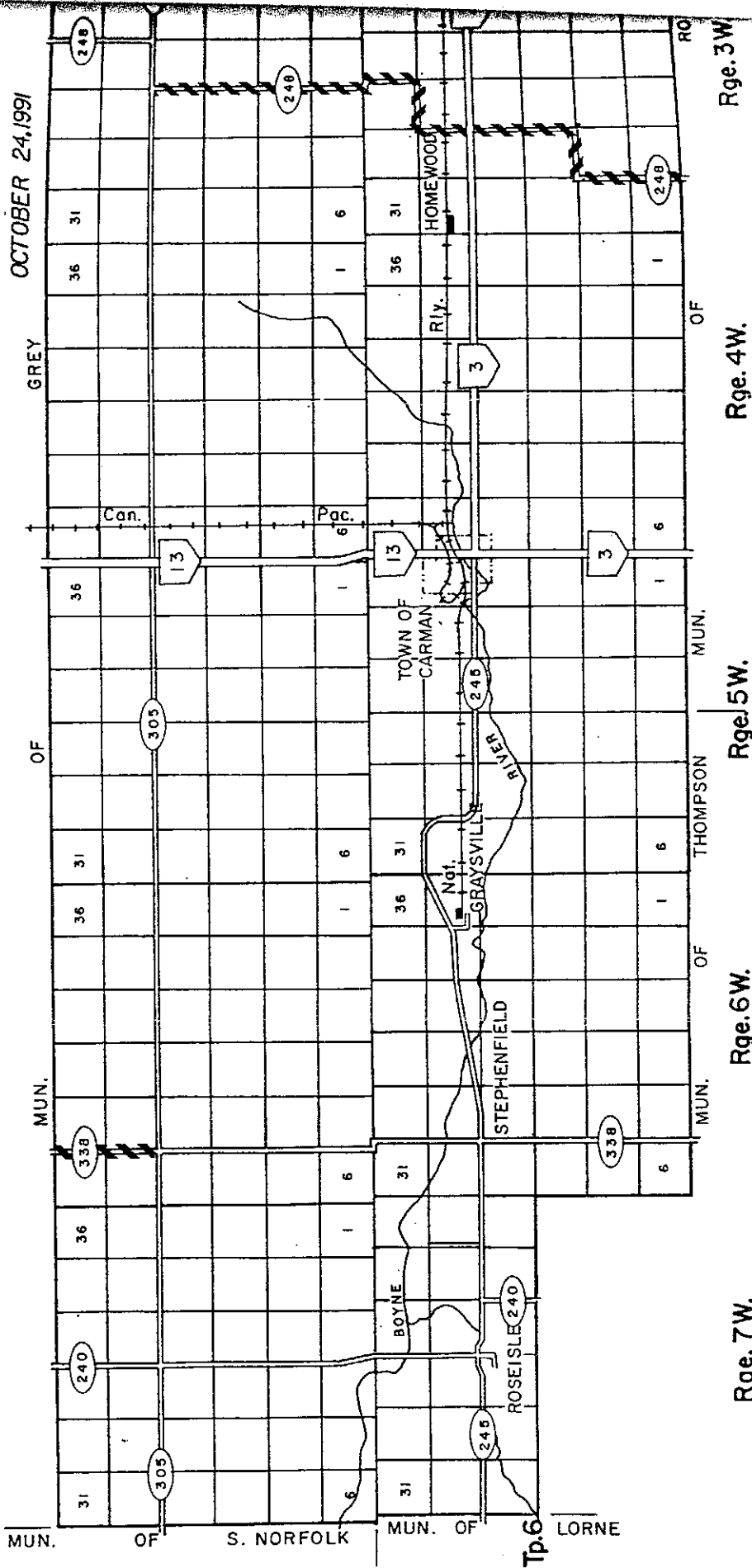
