

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN

By-Law No. 1640

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin
to provide for the granting of municipal assistance to
persons in need and to repeal By-Law No. 1599

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, C.C.S.M. c. M225, as amended by The Social Allowances Amendment and Consequential Amendments Act, S.M. 1992, c.30 requires municipalities to provide municipal assistance in accordance with The Social Allowances Act, C.C.S.M. c.S160, as amended by The Social Allowances Amendment and Consequential Amendments Act, S.M. 1992, c.30 and the Municipal Assistance Regulation;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Assistance Regulation, being Regulation Number 191/92 registered October 16, 1992 requires that each municipality shall make a by-law designating the position of those municipal employees who are authorized to administer municipal assistance;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Assistance Regulation entitles a municipality to Provincial cost sharing for any resulting increase in the cost of municipal assistance where the municipality has, by by-law, established an exemption from the earned income of applicants and/or recipients, which exemption is shareable by the Government of Canada under the terms of the Canada Assistance Plan;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin, in regular session assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That this by-law may be referred to as "the Rural Municipality of Dufferin Municipal Assistance By-Law".
2. That the employee designated to administer municipal assistance in the Rural Municipality of Dufferin is the Administrator.
3. That By-Law No. 1599 of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin is hereby repealed.
4. That this by-law comes into force on April 1, 1993.
