

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN

By-Law No. 1647

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin
relating to the Greenwood Cemetery

WHEREAS Section 340 (a) of The Municipal Act, R.S.M. 1988, authorizes the council of any municipality to pass by-laws "for acquiring land for public cemeteries";

BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin that the following described property:

Parcel I: The Ely 517 feet of the Wly 880 feet of the Sly 309 feet of the Nly 792 feet of the SW 1/4 19-6-4 WPM.

Parcel II: The most Sly 120 feet in width of the most Nly 483 feet in depth of the most Ely 517 feet in depth of the most Wly 880 feet in width of the SW 1/4 19-6-4 WPM.


be purchased from Robert Howard Billing, jointly with the Town of Carman, for a purchase price of \$28,500.00.
