

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN

By-Law No. 1733

Being a by-law to authorize the expenditure and borrowing of funds for the completion of Phase 6 Rural Water Line System.

WHEREAS the provisions of the Municipal Act, S.M. 1996, c.58, provides in part as follows:

If approved by by-law, a municipality may undertake, as a local improvement for the benefit of all or part of the municipality,

- (a) the acquisition, development, upgrading or replacement of one or more of the following:*
 - ii) water supply, treatment and distribution facilities;*

AND WHEREAS subsection 320 (1) of the Act provides as follows:

Subject to subsections (2) and (6) and subsection 321(4), a council may by by-law

- (a) approve the local improvement or special service as set out in the plan or proposal;*
- and*
- (b) authorize the municipality to impose taxes as set out in the plan or proposal.*

AND WHEREAS section 172 of the Act provides in part as follows:

In this Division,

“Borrowing” means the borrowing of money, and includes

- (b) borrowing to pay for a local improvement under Division 4 (Local Improvements and Special Services) of Part 10,*

AND WHEREAS Section 174(1) of the Act provides in part as follows:

A municipality may make a borrowing only if

- (a) the borrowing is authorized by bylaw;*
- (b) subject to subsection (2), the borrowing is set out as a debt obligation in the operating budget or capital budget or it is made to fund an expenditure authorized under subsection 169(5);*

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin has prepared Local Improvement Plan No. 2/2000 providing for spending and borrowing authority for the construction of a rural water line system – Phase 6 as a local improvement pursuant to Part 10 of the Act.

AND WHEREAS the requirements as prescribed in sections 318, 319 and 320 of the Act have been complied with;

AND WHEREAS the consecutive annual amounts, including principal and interest required to be raised in each year for 10 years as hereinafter provided, for paying the principal and interest under this by-law are the amounts as set out in Schedule "A" hereto;

AND WHEREAS the amount of existing debenture debt of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin is \$857,969.07 of which no portion of the principal or interest thereon is in arrears.

NOW THEREFORE the council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin enacts as follows:

1. THAT pursuant to subsection 320(1) of the Act, the Rural Municipality of Dufferin approve Local Improvement Plan No. 2/2000 attached hereto as Schedule "B",
2. THAT the Rural Municipality of Dufferin may expend up to ninety seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$97,500.00) by the issue and sale of debentures for the purpose of completing the construction of the proposed Phase 6 of the rural water line system as a local improvement.
3. THAT for the aforesaid project, the municipality may borrow ninety seven thousand and five hundred dollars (\$97,500.00). Such debentures shall be issued by the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and shall be payable at the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce in Carman, Manitoba and shall be dated the 1st day of December A.D., 2000.
4. THAT the said debentures shall bear interest at a rate estimated for the time being at 8% per annum, and subject in any event to the authorization of the Municipal Board at the time of sale, and shall mature in accordance with the maturities set out in Schedule "A" hereto on the 1st day of December in each of the years 2001 to 2010, both inclusive.
5. THAT each of the said debentures shall be signed by the Reeve, or by some other person authorized by by-law to sign same, and the Chief Administrative Officer of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin, and there shall be affixed thereto the corporate seal of the said municipality, and the coupons, if any attached thereto shall be signed by the Chief Administrative Officer.
6. THAT during the currency of the said debentures, namely, in each of the years 2001 to 2010, both inclusive, there shall be raised annually by a special rate of \$4.85 per foot on all the rateable property described in Schedule "C" hereto, according to the frontage thereof, with a minimum/maximum of 200 feet, an amount sufficient to provide for the principal and interest requirements hereunder.
7. THAT pursuant to paragraph 174(3)(d) of the Municipal Act, pending the issue and sale of debentures, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin may agree with a bank or person to borrow from the general funds of the municipality for temporary advances from time to time to meet expenditures incurred for the purpose aforesaid, and the total of such advances shall not exceed ninety seven thousand and five hundred dollars (\$97,500.00).

- 8. THAT during the term of the debentures authorized herein, in any year where debentures remain unissued, the levies may be made as if the debentures had been issued; and upon completion of the project authorized herein, when the final amount of the debt created hereunder is known, the levies shall be applied in reduction of temporary financing, and when issued, the amount and term of debentures shall be reduced accordingly.
- 9. THAT, at any time prior to or within thirty days following the completion of the work, any ratepayer of the area affected by the local improvement as described in Schedule "C" hereto may commute and pay in one principal sum that part of his share of the debt herein authorized in respect of the frontage and/or flankage rates provided herein in the said by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and hereafter no frontage and/or flankage rates shall be levied against the said lands in respect of the debentures to be authorized herein.

Schedule "B" to By-Law No. 1733**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN****LOCAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN #2/2000****PHASE 6 – RURAL WATER LINE SYSTEM****A. Description of the Proposed Local Improvement**

The local improvement proposed herein involves the provision of additional authority to expend and borrow funds for the completion of Phase 6 of the rural water line system for the Rural Municipality of Dufferin.

Phase 6 represents the sixth phase of the rural water line system project for this municipality, Phase 4 having been completed in 1999, Phase 5 currently underway and phase 6 scheduled for fall of 2000 or spring of 2001 (dependant on the weather this fall).

B. Local Improvement District to be Taxed

The Local Improvement Tax required to service the debt to be issued under this proposal will be levied on qualifying properties within the Rural Municipality of Dufferin Local Improvement Phase 6 Rural Water Line System.

C. Identification of Potential Taxpayers Under the Plan

The local improvement taxes under this plan are to be imposed in respect of any properties in the Rural Municipality of Dufferin Local Improvement District Phase 6 these properties being only the ones which are serviced with the rural water line system in the 2000 year (second phase of the project).

D. Method of Calculating Local Improvement Tax

The local improvement tax to be levied under this proposal will be calculated on the basis of a frontage levy against all properties in the local improvement district described in Schedule "C" attached hereto, with a minimum/maximum of 200' frontage. This frontage levy will be equivalent to \$6,500.00 plus interest thereon for the ten year duration of the levy commencing in the year 2001 until 2010, both inclusive. This \$6,500.00 represents the total \$7,500.00 charge for the rural water line service less the deposit which has been paid to the Rural Municipality of Dufferin to ensure the water service connection.

Taxpayers will be permitted to pay the \$6,500.00 balance prior to March 1st, 2001 instead of having a frontage tax levied against their property for the years 2001 until 2010, both inclusive.


