THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN

By-law No. 1786

A by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin With respect to persons, activities and facilities on certain municipal property located within the Village of Roseisle, Manitoba.

WHEREAS Section 232(1) of *The Municipal Act* provides, in part, as follows:

"A council may pass by-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters:

- (a) the safety, health, protection and well-being of people and the safety and protection or property;
 - (b) people, activities and things in, on or near a public place or a place open to the public, including parks, ... and facilities that are exempt from municipal taxation"

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Dufferin is the legal owner of the property legally described as:

"All that portion of Railway Right-of-Way and Station Grounds Plan 754 MLTO (C Div) in the NE ¼ 21-6-7 WPM which lies between the Westerly limit of Water Control Works Plan 20522 MLTO and the Westerly limit and its straight production of the said Station Grounds excepting all Mines and Minerals as set forth in Deed 146552 MLTO;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin has been petitioned by several citizens of the Village of Roseisle to provide recreational land for a picnic shelter, a baseball diamond, a lawn-mower racetrack as well as their July 1st fireworks celebrations;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin considers these events to be in the best interest of the citizens of the community as a whole;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin, in regular session assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. THAT the Rural Municipality of Dufferin approve the use of the above property for the purposes agreed to in the preamble;
- 2. THAT the Rural Municipality of Dufferin requires all activities be carried on in accordance with any applicable legislation;
- 3. THAT the Rural Municipality of Dufferin assumes no liability for the said activities and that nay organization shall indemnify and save harmless the Rural Municipality from all liability.
