



RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN

By-law No. 1879

BEING A BY-LAW of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin for the purpose of authorizing remuneration of Committee Members.

WHEREAS Section 85 (1) provides as follows:

“85(1) A council may by by-law delegate any of its powers, duties or functions under a by-law of this or any other Act to the head of council, a council committee, the chief administrative officer or a designated officer, unless the by-law or Act otherwise provides.”

AND WHEREAS certain committee members appointed by council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin are not entitled to remuneration while in attendance at regular or special meetings of a board, commission or other body;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin deems it to be in the best interest of the Municipality to authorize payment of said remuneration;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED as a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin as follows;

1. THAT citizen members of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin appointed to the:
  - a. Carman Dufferin Recreation Commission
  - b. Boyne Regional Library
  - c. Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee
  - d. Carman Community Health Centre Boardbe allowed remuneration for each regularly scheduled monthly meeting in the performance of his or her duties on the board, society, committee or corporation for \$25.00 for each meeting, but no more than \$300.00 per annum;
2. THAT in addition a citizen member of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin appointed to the position of Chairperson for said board, society, commission or corporation shall be paid an annual stipend of \$250.00 for a full year or otherwise prorated;
3. THAT citizen members of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin appointed to said board, society, commission or corporation be paid mileage when attending a regularly scheduled monthly meeting in the amount of \$0.40/km;
4. THAT this remuneration is allowable only if the board, society, commission or corporation does not pay the aforementioned remuneration;

5. THAT payment of the remuneration referred to herein shall be authorized by resolution of council upon submission of a statement from the committee member to the Rural Municipality of Dufferin;
6. THAT by-law no. 1854 be rescinded and


