



RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUFFERIN

By-Law No. 1930

**Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin
for the purpose of creating a Recreation Capital Reserve for Capital Purchases for
Recreation to be used within the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and the Town of Carman.**

WHEREAS subsection 168(1) of The Municipal Act provides as follows:

“A council may by by-Law establish reserve funds for any general or specific purpose”;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Dufferin deems it necessary to create a reserve for funds to accommodate the Capital Purchases for Recreation to be used within the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and the Town of Carman;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Dufferin enacts as follows:

1. That a Recreation Capital Reserve for the Capital Purchases for Recreation to be used within the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and the Town of Carman be and hereby is established.
2. That the Council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin deems it expedient to levy the sum of \$50,000.00 for the Recreation Capital Reserve, these monies to be utilized specifically for Capital Purchases for Recreation to be used within the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and the Town of Carman.
