

CAMPGROUNDS

Effective May 4, campgrounds, may open if people maintain a distance of at least two metres, except for brief exchanges. This requirement will be enforceable under the public health order.

Guidelines:

- No more than 10 people may gather in common areas. Congregation of people should be actively discouraged.
- Users must bring their own toilet paper, hand sanitizer and other personal hygiene products to campgrounds.
- People who are travelling to a campground,:
 - bring required prescription drugs and medical supplies before travel;
 - gas up before leaving home;
 - pack out what was packed in and leave no trace;
 - wear water shoes or sandals while using shower facilities; and
 - not use local health providers, unless it is an emergency.

Public health officials continue to advise Manitobans to stay home as much as possible to prevent the spread of COVID-19. When people do go out, they should take steps to maintain physical distancing. Do not travel if you or any of your family members require medical care or have symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing)
