Campground Cancellation Policy:

- All reservations for Carman's King Park Campground require payment at the time of reservation. By creating a reservation, the customer agrees to abide by all applicable rules and regulations that are conditions of a camping reservation. The customer also agrees to be bound by the cancellation policies in effect. A non-refundable \$10.00 reservation fee applies to all reservations per site.
- You can cancel your reservation and collect a full refund on your camping fees (except for the \$10.00 reservation fee per site), if you cancel 4 or more days before your arrival date. If your cancellation occurs 3 days or less before the arrival date, your fees will be refunded except for the first night's camping fee for each site. Remember, if you don't cancel your reservation or do not show up, all fees are forfeited.
- Refunds will not be given due to inclement weather or pool closures.

Campground Rules and Regulations

- Sites are available after 2:00pm the day of your arrival.
- Sites must be vacated by 12:00pm your check out day.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00pm to 8:00am; this includes shutting off generators during this time.
- Fire wood is available for sale at 3 pm daily.
- Pets: must be leashed and attended at all times, owners are responsible for disposal of fecal matter and keeping the volume of the pet(s) at a reasonable level.
- Each campsite is designed for one camping unit. A camping unit would be defined as a tent, tent-trailer, travel trailer, truck-camper, motorhome or fifth wheel. If space allows, an additional tent and dining tent may also be used.
- We are not responsible for accidents, damage to property, thefts or losses. Please lock your valuables and vehicles to prevent theft.
- Violent or aggressive behavior from campers (or their visitors) will result in eviction of the entire group.
- Garbage and Recycling: closed tightly (in bags), placed in garbage dumpster or recycling bins located at the bottom of the hill of the north east side of the campground.
- Fires: allowed only in designated fire pits, fire pits are not to be moved for any reason.
- You may be asked at any time to present your receipt and/or identification as proof of registration.
