

CALLING THE COUNCIL TO ORDER

A special meeting of the Council of the Town of Carman was called by Mayor Brent Owen and held on Friday, March 4, 2022 at 7:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of Memorial Hall. The members of Council were notified about the meeting on Wednesday, March 2, 2022, by Mayor Owen via email.

Mayor Owen called the meeting to order at 7:00 a.m.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the following:

Vaccination Policy – The committee reviewed the existing Vaccination Policy and developed a standard response to questions regarding the policy. The committee felt the policy should be amended by removing the RM of Dufferin and adding a clear statement regarding the fact that the town will follow the Public Health Order as they are changed and updated.

Organization By-law – The draft Organization By-law was reviewed by Council and can move forward with readings.

Director of Economic Development and Coordinator of Municipal Services – The Council reviewed the draft job descriptions and budgets and feel they can be shared with the RM of Dufferin and approved if found acceptable with our partner.

2022 Financial Plan – Council reviewed the document that compared the impact of a one-mill increase and felt this would be acceptable to move forward with this increase for 2022.


By-law No. 21/2050 - being a by-law of the Town of Carman to establish sewer and water rates within the said Town.
