

CAMPGROUNDS GUIDELINES COVID 19

Effective June 21st, 2020

Residents of Western Canada and Northwestern Ontario do not need to self-isolate for 14 days when entering Manitoba.

- Travellers from all other Canadian jurisdictions will need to continue to self-isolate for 14 days after arriving in Manitoba. Anyone entering Canada must continue to follow federal requirements for self-isolation at the time of entry.

Please maintain a distance of at least two meters (six feet), except for brief exchanges from people you are not camping with. This requirement will be enforceable under the public health order.

People who are travelling to a campground,

- pack out what was packed in and leave no trace;
- wear water shoes or sandals while using shower facilities; and
- not use local health providers, unless it is an emergency

Public health officials continue to advise Manitobans to stay home as much as possible to prevent the spread of COVID-19. When people do go out, they should take steps to maintain physical distancing. Do not travel if you or any of your family members require medical care or have symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing)
