Just a reminder that your dogs and cats are to be licensed in the Town of Carman. All animals must have proof of current vaccinations when registering your animals. Licences run the calendar year and are \$15.00 per animal.

Municipal Election Voting
Options**

If you are unable to attend the polls on Municipal election day to vote for your Town Council, there are other options available.

1. Apply to the SEO to vote by sealed envelope (ballot). May apply to SEO between September 28 and October 23.
2. Advance Poll – Wednesday, October 5 from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.; Thursday, October 13, and Tuesday October 18 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

All advance polls will be at the Town office, Memorial Hall, 12-2nd Avenue SW. Call SEO at 204-745-2443 for more information.

Permit reminder

A building permit is required for the construction of any new projects over 120 square feet. This includes but is not limited to new homes, garages, house additions, decks, and sheds. A permit is also required for any building renovations with structural changes or a value over \$20,000.

This includes residential or commercial buildings. A demolition permit is required for the demolition of any building, structure, or part thereof. A Moving Permit is required if you are relocating any structure. Please allow for up to two weeks for the processing of the permit.
