Solid Waste Program

Changes coming to Garbage, Recycling and Compost Collection



The current Special Services by-law for the solid waste program offered to town residents is coming to an end December 31, 2020. As part of the town's Strategic Plan, the Council of the Town of Carman has been working hard to update and improve on the Garbage, Recycling and Compost program within our community. Council had hoped to have presented a new program this fall, however with the resurgence of Covid-19 restrictions, a public hearing has been paused until the public health order would allow such an event.

Council felt it was important to share some of the ideas that have been presented and discussed around the Council table. Pricing has been obtained to pursue having garbage, recycling and compost collection completed via a cart system. This would mean that each residence would receive three carts – one for each type of collection. Moving to a cart collection system is pricing out very competitive and appears to show a cost savings to the town. This system would create greater curb appeal to our community and free up employees to complete other tasks for the Town of Carman. At this time, Council is not prepared to announce the company that will be awarded the contract, and this will be done once a public hearing can be scheduled.

Council is excited to move forward in the spring of 2021 with a new and highly efficient system for this waste collection. Please watch your mailbox for more information on the unveiling of this new program. Because of Public Health Order restrictions, Council may move forward with the costs of the new solid waste program being incorporated within its operating general mill rate for one tax year.

Annual Animal Licenses



A Reminder to all residence, that By-Law No. 10-1950 regulates animals within the Town of Carman. All animals must be vaccinated and licensed annually. License fee is \$15.00 per animal and due on January 1st.

Current rabies tag number is required.

REMINDER - No person shall permit an animal to run at large within the Town. Also, no person shall permit an animal to defecate on property other than the property of its owner without causing such excrement to be removed immediately.

Business Licenses

It's that time of year to renew Business Licenses for 2021! Business licenses are required by any transient trader or business operating in the Town not having a commercial storefront. The annual fee of \$100.00 is due on the 1st day of January.
