

Information for Carman Campground Visitors



Provincial Response Level: CRITICAL
All Carman Campground visitors must adhere to current public health orders.

- Practice physical distancing in Carman Campground. Keep two metres away from anyone not in your household.
- Campgrounds are considered private residences, meaning only people in the same household are allowed in your site.
- Face masks must be worn while inside all buildings including washrooms, pool change house, and shelters.
- Wash your hands or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer regularly.
- Stay home when sick. Do not visit parks if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or if you or someone in your household are required to self-isolate.

Please bring your own hand sanitizer.

Practice Leave No Trace. Pack out everything you packed in including trash and waste, and keep pets on a short leash.

Wear water shoes or sandals while using shower facilities

Only visit local health centres if it is an emergency.

Pool, Playgrounds & Picnic Areas: Follow physical distancing requirements and do not share towels, blankets, toys, food or other items with people outside your household. Keep children within arms reach. Playground equipment is not cleaned or sanitized – wash/sanitize hands before and after use.

Campsite Check-in: Self Check-in – know your site before arriving.

Out-of-province visitors from all jurisdictions must self-isolate for 14 days or for the duration of your stay if it is less than 14 days. **Out-of-province visitors may not self-isolate in a campground.** For more information,
