Measures Put in Place to Protect Patrons & Staff

Carman Dufferin Pool and Campgroup reserve the right to cancel or modify the schedules and activities.

- **Out-of-province visitors** from all jurisdictions must self-isolate for 14 days or for the duration of your stay if it is less than 14 days. **Out-of-province visitors may not self-isolate in a campground.** For more information, visit:

- COVID-19 screening, masks, handwashing & physical distancing signage throughout.
- Use the Province of Manitoba's COVID-19 self-screening tool prior to each pool use & stay home if you are unwell.

- Proper mask usage always required in the Aquatic Facility.
- Water fountain will be closed.
- Extra staff put in place to facilitate physical distancing & cleaning protocols. Hand Sanitizing stations throughout the facility.
- Any equipment used will be sanitized in between uses.
- Lessons, public swim, aquafit and lap swim have been arranged to ensure physical distancing between timeslots.
- Do not arrive any more than 5 minutes before your scheduled timeslot to allow staff time to disinfect between groups.
- All registrants are required to shower & change at home.
- Participants/Observers will sit 2 meters apart.



Carman-Dufferin Pool

- Gather belongings promptly at the end of timeslot & vacate the facility to allow for the next group of swimmers to enter.
- Capacity for the Carman-Dufferin Pool is 75 patrons during public swim.
- One observer per participant allowed during swimming lessons.
- All class sizes have been reduced to allow for physical distancing.
- All classes are 30 minutes in length, except for Level 7/8 and 9/10, which will be 45 minutes in length.
- Participants in levels 1-4 are encouraged to bring their own lifejacket if possible.
- Instructors will practice physical distancing during lessons, only brief exchanges may occur.
- If additional support is necessary, parent/guardian will be required to be in the water.
- **Additional restrictions or changes may be implemented at any time.**
- **Carman Dufferin Recreation staff reserve the right to refuse service if public health guidelines are not followed.**
