

Information for Carman Campground Visitors



Provincial Response Level: RESTRICTED

All provincial park visitors must adhere to current public health orders.

- Practice physical distancing in Carman Campground. Keep two metres away from anyone not in your household.
- Group visits and events are subject to gathering size restrictions.
- Face masks must be worn while inside all buildings including washrooms, pool change house, and shelters.
- Wash your hands or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer regularly.
- Stay home when sick. Do not visit parks if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or if you or someone in your household are required to self-isolate.

Please bring your own hand sanitizer.

Practice Leave No Trace. Pack out everything you packed in including trash and waste, and keep pets on a short leash.

Wear water shoes or sandals while using shower facilities

Only visit local health centres if it is an emergency.

Pool, Playgrounds & Picnic Areas: Follow physical distancing requirements and do not share towels, blankets, toys, food or other items with people outside your household. Keep children within arms reach. Playground equipment is not cleaned or sanitized – wash/sanitize hands before and after use.

Campsite Check-in: Self Check-in – know your site before arriving.

Out-of-province visitors who are fully vaccinated (have received two shots and 14 days have passed since receiving the second shot) may camp in a park, providing they are not showing any symptoms of Covid-19. Visitors who are not fully vaccinated must self-isolate for 14 days or for the duration of your stay if it is less than 14 days upon entering Manitoba. **Persons entering Manitoba who are required to self-isolate cannot do so at a campsite**, unless they are residents of Manitoba and their recreational vehicle or camper trailer is their permanent residence in Manitoba and will be at one campsite location for the duration of their stay in the province, and they can self-isolate without leaving their RV or camper trailer and without interacting with other persons.
