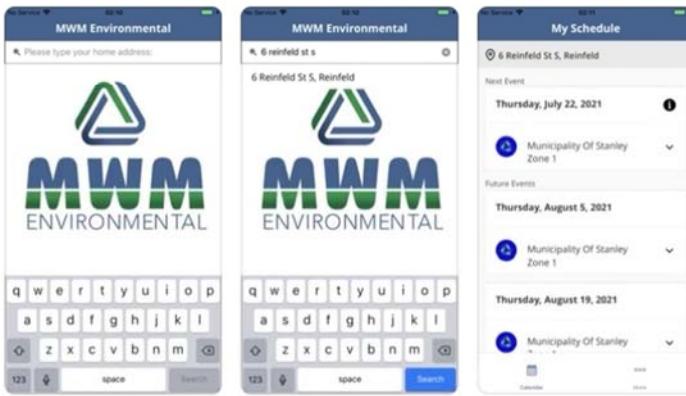

**Annual Animal Licenses**

A Reminder to all residence, that By-Law No. 10-1950 regulates animals within the Town of Carman. All animals must be vaccinated and licensed annually. License fee is \$15.00 per animal and due on January 1st. Current rabies tag number is required.

REMINDER - No person shall permit an animal to run at large within the Town. Also, no person shall permit an animal to defecate on property other than the property of its owner without causing such excrement to be removed immediately!

**Recommended Minimum Ice Thickness  
for New Clear Hard Ice**

No ice is without some risk.  
Measure clear hard ice in several places.



**7cm (3")  
or less  
STAY OFF**



**10cm (4")**

ice fishing,  
skating,  
walking,  
cross-country skiing



**12cm (5")**

one vehicle -  
ATV or snowmobile,  
or one large group  
of people



**20-30cm  
(8-12")**

one vehicle -  
car or light truck



**30-38cm  
(12-15")**

one vehicle -  
medium truck or SUV

*With the return of the snow, we would like to remind residents, the Town strives to plow and sand all roads in a timely manner. Priority is given to Police, Fire and Emergency vehicles. The downtown area is cleared before businesses open. Once this is complete, crews move to the residential areas, starting with avenues and then moving to streets. Back lanes will be the last to be cleared.*

*Please do your part to help the crews clear the streets by removing all parked vehicles from the street during or as soon after a snow fall event. This will allow the crew to provide efficient snow removal as quickly as possible. If vehicles are on the street when equipment arrives, they will be towed at the expense of the owner.*
