

Bylaw. No 93.

Whereas it is deemed expedient to pass a bylaw under the powers conferred by the Municipal Act and amendments thereto for regulating & licensing any person or persons or companies doing business as such within the Village

Therefore the Municipal Council of the Village of Carman enacts as follows

Every person or theatrical company exhibiting or doing business as such within the Village of Carman shall first pay a license fee of Ten Dollars for each day exhibiting or doing business in the Village and obtaining a license therefore. And any person or Company guilty of a breach of the provisions of this bylaw or ^{infinging} the same, shall on conviction before any Justice of the Peace or Public Magistrate forfeit and pay at the discretion of such Justice of Peace or Magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of fifty Dollars and costs to be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of any such offender or offenders as provided by law.
