

Bylaw No 29

For appointing and defining the duties of a
Secretary-treasurer of the Village of Casman,
for the year A.D. 1901

Whereas it is necessary and expedient to
pass a Bylaw for appointing a Secretary-
treasurer for the Village of Casman and
for defining his duties
Therefore the Council of the Village of
Casman enacts,

- 1 That Thomas Kermiffan of Casman,
do, and hereby is appointed Secretary-
treasurer of the Village of Casman,
with such duties as law defined by
the Municipal Act, and such other
duties as may be defined, or imposed
by Bylaw or Resolution of this Council
- 2 That before entering upon the duties
of his office he shall give security
acceptable to this Council, to the
amount of six thousand Dollars
for the due and faithful performance
of his duties as such Secretary-treasurer
- the form of such security to be
approved by the Council of the
Village of Casman
- 3 That he be paid, as remuneration for
his services as Secretary-treasurer,
the sum of ~~four hundred~~ ^{five hundred} Dollars per
Annum, together with all fees
for Tax certificates and the free
use of an office
