

## Bylaw No 65.

A Bylaw of the Town of Carman for the appointment of a Solicitor for the said Town for the year A.D. 1909.

Whereas it is necessary and expedient to appoint a Solicitor for the Town of Carman therefore the Council of the Town of Carman enacts as follows:

That H. E. Robison be and is hereby appointed Solicitor for the Town of Carman, for the year A. D. 1909 provided that his duties as Council shall not necessitate his absence from the said Town as said Council and that in case such absence be necessary then he will receive the usual fees taxable by such Council against the said Town.

That the said H. E. Robison be paid the sum of Fifty Dollars as retainer fee for his services as Solicitor for the said Town.

Provided that in all cases the said H. E. Robison is to receive all fees as taxable against the opposite party in any matter of litigation whatever.

Done and passed in Council Assembled in the Town of Carman this 5th day of January A.D. 1909.
