

BY-LAW NO 213.

A By-law of the corporation of the Town of Carman to authorize the purchase of real property for the use of the Municipality, on which to erect, improve and maintain a Hall and other houses and buildings required by the corporation.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and desirable, jointly with the Rural Municipality of Dufferin, under the provisions of "the Municipal Act", and amendments thereto, to erect, improve and maintain, in the said Town of Carman, a Memorial Hall for the use jointly of the said the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and the corporation of the Town of Carman, to be used for Municipal and other offices and for such other purposes as to the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and to the corporation of the Town of Carman may seem meet, and particularly as a memorial to our noble soldiers, who made such great sacrifices in the Great War against Germany and her allies.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary that a site suitable for the purposes aforesaid be secured.

AND WHEREAS the Councils of the said the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and the corporation of the Town of Carman, with citizens of the two Municipalities, acting as a committee, have recommended that the lands and premises hereinafter particularly described are suitable for the purposes aforesaid.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the corporation of the Town of Carman are agreed that the lands and premises hereinafter particularly described are suitable for the

purposes aforesaid.

NOW THEREFORE, the Mayor and Council of the corporation of the Town of Carman, in Council assembled enact as follows :-

THAT the corporation of the Town of Carman, jointly with the Rural Municipality of Dufferin, purchase as a suitable site, for the purposes aforesaid, under the provisions of "The Municipal Act", and amendments thereto, the following lands and premises, situate, lying and being in the Town of Carman, in the Province of Manitoba, and being described as the mostly northerly 12 feet of Lot Twelve (12) and Lots Thirteen (13) to Twenty-one (21) both inclusive, all in Block Two (2), as shown on a plan of survey of a part of the Town of Carman, filed in the Carman Land Titles Office as Plan No. 24.

THAT the purchase price for the said lands and premises shall be the sum of Four Thousand and Fifty Dollars (\$4050.00).

THAT the title to the said lands and premises be secured in the joint names of the said the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and the corporation of the Town of Carman.

THAT the cost of the said site be borne by the said the Rural Municipality of Dufferin and the corporation of the Town of Carman in the proportion and according to the manner provided in "The Municipal Act" and amendments thereto.
