

Bylaw No 98

A. Bylaw of the Village of Carman to appoint a Police Officer.

Whereas it is necessary to pass a Bylaw appointing a Police Officer for the Village of Carman & for defining his duties.

Now therefore the Council of the Village of Carman acts as follows:

(1.) That James Landa be, and is hereby appointed Police Officer for the said Village of Carman with such duties as are defined by Statute or Bylaw or by Resolution of Council.

(2.) That the said James Landa be paid the sum of Fifty-five Dollars \$ (55.00) per month for his services as such Officer.
