

BY-LAW NO. 298

WHEREAS the Town of Garman did on the 16th day of October A.D. 1923 hold a tax sale of lands then in arrears for taxes due the said Town for which said lands were then liable to be sold under the provisions of the Municipal Assessment Act and amendments thereto.

AND WHEREAS the said Town became the purchaser of certain lands at the said tax sale and Certificates of such purchase issued to the said Town for the several parcels so purchased.


AND WHEREAS it is desirable that the said several tax sale certificates and all the interest of the Town therein be sold and transferred to any purchaser or purchasers as opportunity offers, and whether before or after application for title made in pursuance of said tax sale; but in no case for less than the amount required to redeem any such parcel of land, together with all costs relating thereto.


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Garman in Council assembled enacts as follows: -

THAT the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer of the Town are hereby authorized and required to sell and transfer any or all of the said tax sale certificates and to execute proper transfers or assignments therefor, and to affix the seal of the town thereto.

All transfers of any of said tax sale certificates arising out of said tax sale heretofore made are hereby ratified and confirmed.
