

BYLAW NO. 359.

A Bylaw of the Town of Carman for submitting Bylaw No.16 of the School District of Carman to the electors, which said Bylaw No. 16 relates to the creation of a debt of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$12,500.00) for the purpose of installing a heating and ventilating plant and waterworks.

WHEREAS Bylaw No.16 of the said School District of Carman entitled, "Bylaw of the School Trustees for "The School District of Carman Number 176", for the purpose of borrowing the sum of Twelve Thousand five Hundred Dollars, and of issuing debentures therefor," has been introduced and read a first and second time by the Municipal Council of the said Town of Carman.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Carman in council assembled enacts as follows: -

(1) The said Bylaw No. 16 shall be submitted to the electors qualified to vote thereon on the 31st day of May, A.D. 1928, and for the purpose of taking the votes thereon the Polls shall be open and remain open from the hour of Nine (9) o'clock in the forenoon to the hour of Five (5) o'clock in the afternoon of said date at the following place, namely, the Memorial Hall in the said Town of Carman.

(2) The Returning Officer for taking the said votes shall be Albert Malcolmson, Secretary-Treasurer of the said Town of Carman.

(3) On the 30th day of May, A.D. 1928, at the hour of Three (3) o'clock in the afternoon the Mayor of the said Town of Carman shall attend at the Town Council Chambers in the said Town of Carman for the purpose of appointing persons to attend at the said Polling place and also to attend at the official summing up of the votes hereinafter referred to by the Secretary-Treasurer, on behalf of the persons interested in the said Bylaw and of promoting or opposing the passing of the said Bylaw respectively.

(4) On the 1st day of June, A.D. 1928, at the said Town Council Chambers in the said Town of Carman, at the hour of Five (5) o'clock in the afternoon the said Secretary-Treasurer of the said Town of Carman shall sum up the number of votes given for and against the said Bylaw.
