

BYLAW NO. 415

A Local Option Bylaw of the Town of Carman under The Government Liquor Control Act 1928.

WHEREAS The Government Liquor Control Act 1928 provides for the licensing of beer parlours for the sale of beer by the glass.

AND WHEREAS it is provided by said Act that in certain districts specified a petition may be presented to the Council of the Municipalities concerned requesting the submission of a local option bylaw to the vote of the electors.

AND WHEREAS such a petition has been presented to the Council and it is deemed advisable to grant the prayer of said petition.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carman in session assembled enacts as follows:-

1. No liquor store shall be established, maintained or operated within the limits of the Town of Carman.
2. No beer license or club license shall be granted in respect of any premises within the limits of the Town of Carman.
3. No place shall be fixed or approved of within the limits of the Town of Carman as a place from which a brewer may deliver beer.

THE DATE of Election for voting on this Bylaw shall be the 27th day of *November* A.D. 1931.

TOWN OF CARMAN. LOCAL OPTION BYLAW NO. 415

Notice is hereby given that Bylaw No. 415 of the Town of Carman, in the Province of Manitoba, providing to prohibit the local sale of liquor as defined by Section 251 of The Government Liquor Control Act, 1928, has received its first and second reading by the Council of the said Town, and will be submitted to the vote of the electors of the said Town entitled to vote thereon on Friday, November 27, 1931, between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and five o'clock in the afternoon at the Memorial Hall in the Town of Carman. The Mayor of the said Town shall, on Thursday the 26th day of November, A.D. 1931, from the hour of Two o'clock to the hour of Three o'clock in the afternoon attend at the office of the Clerk of the Council of the said Town, for the appointment of persons to attend at the polling place and at the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk, respectively, on behalf of the persons interested in and promoting or opposing the passing of this Bylaw. On Saturday, the 28th day of November, A.D. 1931, beginning at the hour of Two o'clock in the afternoon, at his office, the Clerk of the Council of the said Town shall sum up the number of votes given for and against this Bylaw. That the proposed Bylaw or a true copy thereof can be seen on file in the office of the Clerk of the Town of Carman. That after taking the vote of the electors entitled to vote thereon, further consideration of the said bylaw shall be on the ^{11th} ~~Seventh~~ day of December, 1931, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. in the Council Chambers in the Memorial Hall, Carman.
