

Bylaw No 501.

A Bylaw of the Town of Carman for the cancellation of taxes on parcels of land situate within the Town, for cancellation of certain business tax and uncollectable accounts.

Whereas the Town of Carman has obtained title to certain pieces or parcels of land situate therein and whereas it is necessary to cancel accrued taxes against the same, therefore the Council of the Town of Carman in Council assembled enacts as follows:
