

BYLAW NO 505.

A Bylaw of the Town of Carman to appoint and define the duties of a Secretary-Treasurer <sup>and clerk</sup> of the said Town.

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to appoin ta Secretary-<sup>and clerk</sup> Treasurer for the Town of Carman and to define his duties; thhrefore the Council of the Town of Carman enacts as follows:-

THAT A. Malcolmson be and is hereby appointed Sceretary-Treasurer <sup>and clerk</sup> of the Town of Carman with such duties as are defined by the Municipal Act and amemdments thereto, and such other duties that may be imposed by bylaw or resolution of the Council.

THAT the said Secretary-Treasurer <sup>and clerk</sup> shall be paid the sum of Fifteen hundred and sixty Dollars per annum, payable monthly, together with all fees for tax certificates, and that all expenditures for office, postage and stationery be allowed him in connection with such office as Sceretary-Treasurer <sup>and clerk</sup>.
