

WHEREAS "The Municipal Act" requires every municipal corporation on or before the first day of February in each year to make estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the corporation for the year in which said sums are required to be levied, and to pay all its debts falling due within the year, making due allowances for taxes imposed on lands purchased by the corporation at tax sale and considered uncollectable and for the cost of collection and the abatement of losses which may occur in the collection of taxes which allowance is hereinafter referred to as a tax reserve.

AND WHEREAS the Town of Carman has made estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the corporation for the year 1940.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary by bylaw or bylaws to levy a rate or rates of so much on the dollar upon the assessed value of all rateable property liable therefor in the municipality as the council deems sufficient to raise the sums required for the lawful purposes of the corporation as shewn by the said estimates.

AND WHEREAS the assessed value of the whole rateable property within the Town of Carman according to the last revised assessment roll thereof is \$777,020.00.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to fix rates of taxation for the purposes aforesaid and the time for payment of all rates and taxes so fixed and levied.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carman in council assembled enacts as follows:-

(1) That the estimates of the Council of the Town of Carman of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the corporation for the year 1940 as set out in Schedule A hereof and identified by the signature of the head of the Council and the Chairman of the Finance Committee are hereby approved.

(2) That the following respective rates of so much on the dollar be and are hereby levied for the year 1940 upon the assessed value of all rateable property in the municipality respectively liable therefor according to the last revised general assessment rolls thereof to raise the sums required for the uncontrollable purposes of the corporation which said rates, assessed values and sums required are set out in Schedule A :-

(a) A general rate of 16 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment to Carman School District and reserve:

(b) A general rate of $1\frac{3}{4}$ mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the amount mentioned and apportioned to the municipality in the statement of certificate of the Municipal Commissioner under the Municipal Commissioner's Act dated December 31st, 1939, and for an allowance for tax reserve Schedule A.

(c) That a general rate of 2 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the amount due and payable in the year 1940 on debentures issued under Bylaws No. 258 and 357 of the municipality and for an allowance for tax reserve Schedule A.

(3) That a general rate of $25\frac{1}{4}$ mills on the dollar made up of the rate or rates be and is hereby levied for the year 1940 upon the assessed value of all rateable property in the municipality liable therefor according to the last revised general assessment roll thereof to provide for the payment of the amount estimated as required for the general controllable purposes of the corporation viz:- Public Works, Protection of Persons and Property, Social Services, Miscellaneous Purposes, Depreciation and Administration and for allowances of Tax reserve Schedule A.

(4) That all taxes and rates imposed and levied for the year 1940 in the Town of Carman shall be deemed to have been imposed and to be due and payable on the 31st day of October, 1940.

(5) On all taxes for the year 1940 paid on or before March 31st 1940 a discount of $5\frac{1}{2}\%$ will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or

before April 30th, a discount of $4\frac{1}{2}\%$ will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before May 31st, a discount of $3\frac{3}{4}\%$ will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before June 30th a discount of 3% will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before July 31st a discount of $2\frac{1}{4}\%$ will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before August 31st a discount of $1\frac{1}{2}\%$ will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before September 30th a discount of $\frac{3}{4}\%$ will be allowed; and all taxes for the year 1940 unpaid on September 30th shall be payable at par up to October 31st, 1940; upon all taxes remaining unpaid after October 31st, 1940, there shall be added on the first day of each month thereafter as a penalty an additional sum amounting to one-half of one percent of such taxes until paid or until the Municipality shall have sold the property liable therefor at tax sale.
