

BYLAW NO. <sup>623</sup>622

A bylaw of the Town of Carman for submitting Bylaw No. <sup>623</sup>622 to the electors, which said Bylaw No. <sup>623</sup>622 relates to the creation of a debt of \$1,559.87 annually for the purpose of constructing, equipping and maintaining a Hospital under "The Health Services Act".

WHEREAS Bylaw No. <sup>623</sup>622 of the said Town of Carman entitled, "A Bylaw of the Corporation of the Town of Carman to authorize the annual levy of \$1,559.87, for the purpose of constructing, equipping and maintaining a Hospital under "The Health Services Act", has been introduced and read a first and second time by the Municipal Council of the said Town of Carman.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Carman in session assembled enacts as follows: -

(1) The said Bylaw No. <sup>623</sup>622 shall be submitted to the electors qualified to vote thereon on the 22nd day of November, A.D. 1946, and for the purpose of taking the votes thereon the Polls shall be open to the hour of Five (5) o'clock in the afternoon of said date at the following place, namely, the Memorial Hall in the said Town of Carman.

(2) The Returning Officer for taking the said votes shall be Albert Malcolmson, Secretary-Treasurer of the said Town of Carman.

(3) On the 21st day of November, A.D. 1946, at the hour of Three (3) o'clock in the afternoon the Mayor of the said Town of Carman shall attend at the Town Council Chambers in the said Town of Carman for the purpose of appointing persons to attend at the said Polling place and also to attend at the official summing up of the votes hereinafter referred to by the Secretary-Treasurer, on behalf of the persons interested in the said Bylaw and of promoting or opposing the passing of the said Bylaw respectively.

(4) On the <sup>22nd</sup>23rd day of November, A.D. 1946, at the said Town Council Chambers in the said Town of Carman, at the hour of ~~Eleven~~ <sup>Eleven</sup> ~~am~~ (5) o'clock in the ~~forenoon~~ <sup>forenoon</sup> the said Secretary-Treasurer of the said Town of Carman shall sum up the number of votes given for and against the said Bylaw.
