

BY-LAW NO. 635

A By-Law of the Town of Carman relating to business carried on by persons not paying the regular business Tax.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to pass a By-Law respecting persons carrying on business within the Town, and not liable for taxation under the regular business tax.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carman in Session assembled, enacts as follows:-

ANY PERSON carrying on any kind of Commercial business in the Town of Carman, who does not pay a business tax, and is not subject to any other By-Law of a similar nature already in force, shall pay to the Town of Carman, a fee in lieu of business tax of Fifteen Dollars a year.

UPON a conviction for a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law, the convicting Magistrate may order the offender to carry out the requirements of this By-Law, within a time to be limited by the order, and in default of the offender carrying out such order the Town Constable or other person duly authorized, shall forthwith at the expense of the offender, take such means to carry out the requirements of this By-Law as shall be necessary, and the expense thereof, with costs, may be recovered by action or distress, and in case of non-payment thereof the same shall be recovered in like manner as municipal taxes.
