

By-Law No. 636.

A By-law of the Town of Carman to regulate Gasoline Filling and Service Stations in the Town of Carman.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented to the Council of The Town of Carman praying for the regulation of Gasoline Filling and Service Stations in the Town of Carman and it is deemed advisable and expedient that the prayer of said petition be granted.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Town of Carman in session assembled enacts as follows:-

1. THAT all Gasoline Filling and Service Stations in the Town of Carman except as mentioned in the following section shall be closed and remain closed between the hours of ten o'clock p.m. of every Saturday until six o'clock a.m. of the following Monday.

2. The exceptions to the last mentioned clause shall be one such station North of the Boyne River and one such station South of the Boyne River in such manner that each station be allowed to keep open every fifth Sunday in the following order.

First Sunday - Hardy's Garage and Leigh Porter

Second Sunday - Floyd's Garage and J. W. Kyle

Third Sunday - Carman Motors and Holtslag Bros.

Fourth Sunday - R. H. Porter's Garage and Stout Bros.

Fifth Sunday - Johnson's Garage and Strong & Armitage

Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall forfeit and pay the following penalties:

Five dollars and costs for the first offence.

Twenty five dollars and costs for every subsequent offence hereunder, and in default of payment of said penalty and costs forthwith, the said penalty and costs, or costs only, may be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the offender, and in case of there being no distress for the use of which such penalty can be levied, the convicting

Magistrate may commit the offender to jail for any period not exceeding six calendar months, unless the said penalty or costs be sooner paid.

This Bylaw shall be deemed to become in force on and after May 5th A.D.1947.
