

BYLAW No 644


A BYLAW of the Town of Carman to appoint and define the duties of a Secretary-Treasurer.


WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient a Secretary-Treasurer and clerk for the Town of Carman and to define his duties, therefore the Council of the Town of Carman enacts as follows:

THAT A. MALCOLMSON be and is hereby appointed Secretary-Treasurer and clerk of the Town of Carman with such duties as are defined by the Municipal Act and amendments thereto, and such other duties that may imposed by Bylaw or Resolution of the Council.

That the said Secretary-Treasurer and clerk shall be paid the sum of One hundred and fifty-five Dollars per month, together with all fees for tax certificates, and that all expenditures for office, postage and stationery be allowed him in connection with such office as Secretary-Treasurer and clerk.
