

A By-Law of the Town of Carman to impose a Poll Tax in said Town.

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to pass a By-law to impose a Poll Tax in the Town of Carman.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carman in session assembled enacts as follows:

1. Every male inhabitant of the Town of Carman of the age of twenty-one years, and under sixty years, who has not been assessed upon the last revised rolls of the Town with respect to property liable to taxation, or is not qualified to be placed on the list of Electors of the Town, or whose taxes do not amount to Four Dollars per year, shall pay a tax of Four Dollars yearly as a Poll Tax.

2. The said Poll Tax shall be due and payable on the *first* day of *June* in each year after the passing of this By-law.

3. Any person liable to payment of said Poll Tax and neglecting to pay same on the due date shall be liable to a penalty of *Ten* Dollars.
