

WHEREAS "The Municipal Act" requires every Municipal Corporation on or before the first day of February in each year to make estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year in which said sums are required to be levied making due allowances for taxes imposed on lands purchased by the Corporation at Tax Sale and considered uncollectable, and for the cost of collection and for the abatement of losses which may occur in the collection of the taxes which allowance is hereinafter referred to as tax reserve.

AND WHEREAS the Town of Carman has made estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year 1952;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary by bylaw or bylaws to levy a rate or rates of so much on the dollar upon the assessed value of all rateable property liable therefor in the municipality as the Council deems sufficient to raise the sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation as shown by the said estimates.

AND WHEREAS the assessed value of the whole rateable property within the Town of Carman is \$1,073,245.00 according to the last revised assessment roll,

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to fix rates of taxation for the purposes as aforesaid, and the time for payment of all rates so fixed and levied:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carman assembled enact as follows:

(1) THAT the estimates of the Council of the Town of Carman of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year 1952 as set out in Schedule "A" hereof and identified by the signature of the head of the Council and the chairman of the Finance Committee are hereby approved.

(2) THAT the following rates of so much on the dollar be and are hereby levied for the year 1952 upon the assessed value of all rateable property in the municipality respectively liable therefor according to the last revised assessment roll thereof, to raise the sums required for the uncontrollable purposes of the Corporation which rates assessed values, and sums required, are set out in Schedule "A".

(a) A General rate of 7.35 mills and a Special rate of 14.65 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment to the Carman School District and reserve.

(b) A GENERAL rate of 1.5 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the amount mentioned and apportioned to the municipality in the Municipal Commissioner's Act, dated January 19, 1952 and for an allowance for tax reserve.

(c) A GENERAL rate of 1 mill on the dollar to provide for the payment of the amount due and payable in the year 1952 on debentures issued under bylaw No. 357 of the Municipality and for an allowance for tax reserve.

(d) A GENERAL rate of 2.5 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the amount due and payable in the year 1952 under Bylaw No. 622

(e) A GENERAL rate of 2 mills on the dollar to provide for Carman Memorial Hospital maintenance.

(f) A GENERAL rate of 3 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of Deferred Levy.


(3) A GENERAL rate of 33 mills on the dollar made up of the rate or rates be and is hereby levied for the year 1952 upon the assessed value of all rateable property in the Municipality liable therefor according to the last revised assessment roll thereof, to provide for the payment of the amounts estimated as required for the general controllable purposes of the Corporation viz: Public Works, Waterworks, Protection of Persons and Property, Social Services, Miscellaneous, and Administration and for the purpose of tax reserve.

(4) THAT all taxes and rates imposed and levied for the year 1952 in the Town of Carman shall be deemed to have been imposed and be due and payable on the 31st day of October 1952.

ON ALL TAXES for the year 1952 paid on or before March 31st a discount of 3 per cent will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before April 30th a discount of 2% will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before May 31st a discount of 1% will be allowed; and all taxes for the year 1952 unpaid on May 31st shall be payable at par up to October 31st 1952. Upon all taxes remaining unpaid after October 31st 1952 there shall be added on the first day of each month thereafter as a penalty an additional sum amounting to one-half of one percentum of such taxes until paid.
