

A BYLAW of the Municipality of the Town of Carman to provide for an annual retiring allowance to Alexander Carcary.

WHEREAS in accordance to Section 378 of "The Municipal Act"

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Carman in recognition of faithful and loyal service rendered to the Town of Carman deems it advisable to grant Alexander Carcary an annual retiring allowance, the payment and amount of said allowance to be subject to review in December of each year.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carman in Council assembled enacts as follows:

1. There shall be paid to said Alexander Carcary as a retiring allowance the sum of \$900.00 annually to commence on the 1st day of January A. D. 1953 and to continue each year with payment and amount of said allowance to be subject to review in December of each subsequent year from the year A.D.1953.

2. The said annual retiring allowance shall be paid in monthly installments of one-twelfth of the said annual sum, on the first day of each and every month, the first of such payments to be made on the first day of February A. D. 1953.

3. The Council of the Municipality of the Town of Carman hereby places on record their appreciation of the loyal, effecient and capable service rendered by the said Alexander Carcary during the period that he has spent in the employment of the said Town of Carman.
