

A BY LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY TOWN OF CARMAN
TO REGULATE THE DISPOSAL OF ASHES WITHIN THE SAID TOWN.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and to the best interests of the Municipality Town of Carman, to regulate the disposal of ashes by residents, owners and occupiers of premises within the limits of the said Municipality,

NOW THEREFORE THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY TOWN OF CARMAN IN OPEN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


HEREAFTER all owners, residents and occupiers of all premises within the limits of said Town shall observe and be governed by the provisions hereinafter set out in respect to the disposal of ashes within the said Town.

All said persons set out above shall dispose of all ashes otherwise than by placing said ashes upon any Lane, street, Boulevard or any Town property within the limits of said Town.

Any person or persons guilty of placing ashes on any ~~Lane~~, Street, boulevard or Town property without the consent in writing of said Town, shall upon conviction thereof before a Police Magistrate or any Justice or Justices of the Peace, having Jurisdiction, either upon the confession of the accused party or by evidence adduced, forfeit and pay at the discretion of the Police Magistrate or Justice or Justices of the Peace, upon conviction or confession of guilt, a fine not exceeding \$ 200 ., and costs for each offence, and in case of non payment of any fine and costs authorized under this By-law it shall be lawful for the Police Magistrate or Justice or Justices of the Peace so convicting as aforesaid to issue a warrant under his hand and seal or their hands and seals, as the case may be, to levy the fine and costs by Distress and sale of the goods and chattels of said person, and in case of non payment of the fine inflicted for any such breach and there being no distress found out of which said fine can be levied it shall and may be

lawful for the Police Magistrate, Justice or Justices of the Peace so convicting, as aforesaid, to commit such person to the Common Goal of the Eastern Judicial District of Manitoba for a period, not exceeding Seven days.
