

WHEREAS "The Municipal Act" requires every Municipal Corporation on or before the fifteenth day of April in each year to make estimates and finalize its budget of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year in which said sums are required to be levied making due allowances for taxes imposed on land purchased by the Corporation at tax sale and considered uncollectable, and for the cost of collection and for the abatement of losses which may occur in the collection of taxes which allowances is hereinafter referred to as tax reserve.

AND WHEREAS the Town of Garman has made estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year 1957;

AND WHEREAS IT IS NECESSARY BY By-law or bylaws to levy a rate or rates of so much on the dollar upon the assessed value of all rateable property liable therefor in the municipality as the council deems sufficient to raise the sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation as shewn by the said estimates;

AND WHEREAS the assessed value of the whole rateable property within the Town of Garman is \$1,936,910. according to the last revised assessment roll,

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to fix rates of taxation for the purposes as aforesaid, and the time for payment of all rates so fixed and levied:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Garman assembled enacts as follows:

(1) THAT the estimates of the Council of the Town of Garman of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year 1957 as set out in Schedule "A" hereof and identified by the signature of the head of the Council and the Chairman of the Finance Committee are hereby approved.

(2) THAT the following rates of so much on the dollar be and are hereby levied for the year 1957 upon the assessed value of all rateable property in the Municipality respectively liable therefor according to the last revised assessment roll thereof, to raise the sums required for the uncontrollable purposes of the Corporation which rates assessed values, and sums required are set out in Schedule "A".

(a) A General rate of 5 mills and a special rate of 18.3 Mills on the dollar to provide for the payment to the Garman Consolidated School and tax reserve.

(b) A. General rate of .9 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the amount due and payable in the year 1957 under by-law No. 622 and tax reserve.

(c) A General rate of .54 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the amount due and payable in the year 1957 on debentures issued under bylaw No. 357

(d) A General rate of .06 Mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the amount due and payable in the year 1957 under bylaw No. 766 and tax reserve.

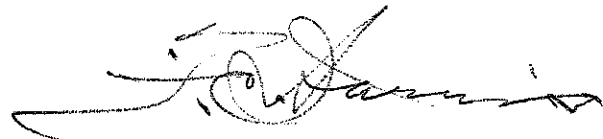
(e) A General rate of 7.8 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of deferred levy and reserve.

(f) A. General rate of .2 millon the dollar to provide for the purpose of tax reserve.

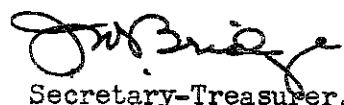
(g) A General rate of 26.6 mills on the dollar made upof the rate or rates be and is hereby levied for the year 1957 upon the assessed value of all rateable property in the Municipality liable therefor according to the last revised assessment roll thereof, to provide for the payment of the amounts estimated as Waterworks, Public Works, Protection of Persons and property, Social Services, Community Services, Fixed Asset Purchases, and Administration and for the purpose of Tax Reserve.

(4) On All Taxes for the year 1957 paid on or before June 30th a discount of 3% will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before July 31st. a discount of 2% will be allowed; on all taxes paid on or before August 31st. a discount of 1 % will be allowed; and all taxes for the year 1957 unpaid after October 31st 1957 there shall be added on the first day of each month thereafter, as a penalty an additional sum amounting to one-half of one percentum of such taxes until paid.

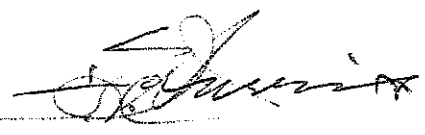
