

A By-Law to amend By-Law No. 838

By-Law No: 881.A

Whereas in By-Law No. 838 an error was made in the occupation of the purchaser described in said By-law, and

Whereas one of the errors set out was in the consideration as the purchase price of the lands described therein, and

Whereas the purchaser therein was described as a Widow, and should have been described as the wife of James McIntosh, and

Whereas the consideration in said By-law was set out as One Dollar, and should have been One hundred and fifty Dollars, and


Whereas the Council of Town of Carman is desirous of correcting said errors in said By-Law,


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF Carman, in regular Council assembled, enacts as follows;

THAT the word Widow, where it appears as the status of the purchaser be deleted, and the words "Wife of James McIntosh" be inserted in its stead.

THAT the words One Dollar (\$1.00) where it appears as the consideration for the sale of the premises described therein be deleted and the words "One hundred and fifty (\$150.00) Dollars be inserted in its stead.
