

Being a By-Law of the Municipality Town of
Carman appointing a Secretary-Treasurer
for the Town of Carman

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and expedient to appoint a Secretary-Treasurer for the Town of Carman; and

WHEREAS the permanent Secretary-Treasurer for the Town of Carman died on August 8th, A.D. 1960, and the position was filled temporarily and applications for the position were invited by public advertisement during the latter part of October and early November; and

WHEREAS the council favored appointing Mr. A.L.Loepky, one of the applicants, and passed a By-Law dated the 28th day of December, A.D. 1960, appointing the said A.L.Loepky Secretary-Treasurer of the Town of Carman; and

WHEREAS all applications were submitted to the Civic Service Board of Manitoba and the Board ruled that the said A.L.Loepky could be appointed on a probationary basis, such probationary period to extend over a period of the next two years subject to examination. At the conclusion of the said probationary period and subject to confirmation by the Board, Mr. Loepky could then be permanently confirmed in the appointment:

THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted a by-law of the Municipality Town of Carman that Mr. A.L.Loepky be and hereby is appointed the probationary Secretary-Treasurer of the Municipality Town of Carman at a salary for the year A.D. 1961 of \$4,560.00, payable in equal monthly payments.

It is hereby enacted that the salary of the said A.L.Loepky, while commencing at \$4,560.00, shall be increased by equal annual increments so that the salary shall have reached the sum of \$5,500.00 as at January 1st, A.D. 1964.

Done and passed by the council of the Municipality Town of Carman, in council assembled, this Thirteenth Day of January, A.D. 1961.
