

TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 936 A

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF CARMAN setting out the duties and rates of remuneration of certain employees of the Town of Carman.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of clause (e) of subsection (1) of section 3 of The Municipal Act, being Chapter 173 of The Revised Statutes of Manitoba, 1954, and amendments thereto, a municipal corporation shall be capable of becoming a party to any contracts or agreements in the management of its own affairs;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and in the best interest of the Town of Carman to set out the rates of remuneration of the employees of the Town of Carman and to define their duties;

NOW THEREFORE, the council of the Town of Carman, enacts as follows:

- (1) That W.H.Eby, foreman, shall be paid a salary of \$ 350.00 per month.
- (2) That J.H.VanDyk, utility man, shall be paid a salary of \$ 250.00 per month.
- (3) That J.M.Arnett, assistant secretary-treasurer, shall be paid a salary of \$ 190.00 per month.
- (4) That M.A.Morrison, water treatment plant operator, shall be paid a salary of \$ 300.00 per month.
- (5) That David Jones, water treatment plant operator, shall be paid a salary of \$ 235.00 per month.
- (6) That Joseph Larocque, water treatment plant operator, shall be paid a salary of \$ 170.00 per month.
- (7) That David Hamilton, garbage collector, shall be paid a salary of \$ 205.00 per month, and that the said David Hamilton be paid an expense allowance of \$ 65.00 per month.
- (8) That casual laborers engaged by the Town of Carman shall be paid at the rate of \$ 1.00 per hour.
- (9) That the employees hereinbefore referred to shall carry out such duties as are or may be assigned to them by officers of the corporation, or by its by-laws and resolutions.
- (10) That this by-law shall be retroactive to the first day of January, A.D. 1963.
