

TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 953

A BY-LAW of The Town of Carman providing for the cancellation of certain taxes and other debts owing to the Town of Carman.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 1188, subsection (1) of The Municipal Act, being Chapter 173 of the Revised Statutes of Manitoba, 1964, and amendments thereto, a municipality, by by-law, may cancel in whole or in part any taxes or any debt or monies owing to the municipality;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed in the best interests of The Town of Carman to cancel said taxes and other debts;

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Town of Carman enacts as follows: (1) That the real property taxes and business taxes set forth in Schedule "A" attached ~~to~~ and forming part of this by-law be and are hereby cancelled.

(2) That other debts owing to the Town of Carman set forth in Schedule "B" attached to and forming part of this by-law be and are hereby cancelled.

(3) That this by-law shall be in full force and effect from and after the day on which the minister of Municipal Affairs certifies that the evidence has been filed with him establishing the bona fides of this by-law and that it is in the best interest of the Town of Carman.
