

THE TOWN OF CARMAN  
BY-LAW NO. 993 ^

A BY-LAW of The Town of Carman selecting a project for Centennial commemoration and authorizing an application for financial assistance in the implementation thereof.

WHEREAS it is deemed fitting that The Town of Carman undertake and implement a project to commemorate the centennial anniversaries of the Confederation of Canada and the formation of the Province of Manitoba;

AND WHEREAS it is considered expedient that the project to be undertaken and implemented for this purpose be the construction of a museum building at King's Park, in The Town of Carman;

AND WHEREAS it is estimated that the total cost of implementing the said project will be fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), apportioned as shown in the form attached as Schedule "A" hereto;

AND WHEREAS it is considered desirable that The Town of Carman participate in the Centennial Grants Program of the Province of Manitoba and the Government of Canada in the implementation of the said project;

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted as a by-law of The Town of Carman as follows:

1. THAT the proper officers of The Town of Carman complete, execute and forward to the Manitoba Centennial Corporation an application in the form attached as Schedule "A" hereto, requesting financial assistance in accordance with the terms of the aforesaid Centennial Grants Program, and that all such assistance be devoted to the implementation of the said project.

All that portion of the South East Quarter of Section Twenty-five (25) in Township Six (6), Range Five (5), West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, and more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a point on the Southern Boundary of said Quarter Section where the Eastern Boundary of the Right-of-Way of the Canadian Pacific Railway intersects with the Southern Boundary of said Quarter Section; Thence extending Eastward along said Southern Boundary of said Quarter Section a Distance of One Hundred and Twenty Feet (120 ft.); Thence Northerly parallel with the Eastern Boundary of said Quarter Section a Distance of One Hundred and Eighty Feet (180 ft.); Thence Westerly parallel with the said Boundary of said Quarter Section to the Eastern Limit of said Right-of-Way; Thence South and Easterly along the Eastern Boundary of said Right-of-Way to the point of commencement.
