

THE TOWN OF CARMAN  
BY-LAW NO. 66/1016 ~

A by-law of The Town of Carman to provide for and authorize the payment of indemnities to the Mayor and Councillors of The Town of Carman.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of subsection 2 of section 309 of The Municipal Act, being Chapter 173 of the Revised Statutes of Manitoba, 1954, and amendments thereto, the council of a Town may, if a by-law of the municipality so provides, in lieu of all other indemnities, except as provided in section 311 of The Municipal Act, pay to the mayor and to each councillor monthly such indemnity as the council determines; but in the case of the Mayor, the indemnity in any one year shall not exceed the sum of two thousand dollars, and, in the case of each councillor, shall not exceed the sum of one thousand dollars;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the best interest of The Town of Carman to provide for and authorize the payment of indemnities to the mayor and each councillor of The Town of Carman for the year A.D. 1966;

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Town of Carman enacts as follows:

- (1) THAT the Mayor shall be paid a monthly indemnity of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).
- (2) THAT each Councillor shall be paid a monthly indemnity of sixty-six dollars and sixty-seven cents (\$66.67).
- (3) THAT the total amount of the indemnities provided for in this by-law shall be paid in the month of December, A.D. 1966.
- (4) THAT this by-law shall be retroactive to the first day of January, A.D. 1966.

DONE AND PASSED in regular council assembled, this thirteenth day of July, A.D. 1966.
