

TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 66/1023

A By-Law of the Town of Carman to authorize the sale of certain lands to Theresa Abercrombie of the Town of Togo, in Saskatchewan, Widow.

WHEREAS THE Council of The Town of Carman deems it expedient and to the best interests of the said Town to sell the hereunder set out premises;

AND WHEREAS the said Town has no further use of the said property and it is not required for the use of the said Town;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Town of Carman, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT there shall be sold by The Town of Carman the hereunder set out lands to the said Theresa Abercrombie of the Town of Togo in the Province of Saskatchewan, Widow, namely: In The Town of Carman, in the Province of Manitoba, and being Lots one (1), two (2), three (3) and four (4), in Block twenty-one (21), which Lots are shewn on a Plan of Survey of a part of the said Town registered in The Carman Land Titles Office as No. 24.

2. THAT the consideration for the sale of the said premises is the sum and amount of One Thousand and Fifty-nine Dollars and Fifty-four Cents (\$1,059.54), the said sum having been fully paid by the said Purchaser.

3. THAT the proper officers of The Town of Carman hereby are authorized to execute, on behalf of the said Town, all documents necessary for the Transfer of the said Lands to the said Purchaser.
